## A little bit of background...

**Out of the Box (Scotland) Ltd** is a regulated Scottish Charity SC 035701, set up in 2004 to provide Christian outreach using puppetry, song and other forms of creative arts.

**Out of the Box** was created by Chris Watt, who is now our full-time Children's Worker. Between September 2005 and September 2009 Chris was the full-time Youth and Children's Worker for Hilton Parish Church, Inverness. He has gained a reputation of excellence within the local primary schools and across the wider community for the energy and enthusiasm he brings to the projects he has undertaken and the various regular events he has been involved in. He has a natural ability to capture the imagination and get alongside children both in small and large group settings.

**Out of the Box** has served many schools, churches and other organisations across Scotland in a variety of different ways, such as:

- Children's Outreach Events
- School Assemblies
- Scripture Union Camps
- Holidays Clubs
- The Royal Highland Show
- Church Services
- Family Events
- Puppet Training Events
- RE classes



Whether it is through a school assembly, a workshop, a one-off event or in the classroom we seek to develop children's **physical, mental, spiritual and emotional well-being**. We want to encourage children to be both **confident individuals** and **responsible citizens**.



We have found that giving children a **"hands on"** experience is the best way to engage interest and to ensure we achieve our aim of **child development**. Giving the space and opportunity to explore creative arts for themselves in an unthreatening, lively way enables every child to contribute – we recognise that every child is unique and special.

## Schools

**A whole day** – Chris would spend the morning with three different groups of children in a workshop setting exploring a particular theme. Workshops would include the use of a variety of creative arts, including puppetry, song and drama. The aim of these workshops being, the involvement of the children in a whole school concert in the afternoon, lasting around 50-60 minutes.

**School Assembly** – Chris would lead an assembly on a given theme or will come prepared with a theme himself.

**RE Classes** – Chris would come and lead an RE Class on any given theme.

**School Musical** – Chris has already directed Joseph and his amazing Technicolor dreamcoat for Hilton Primary School and is currently working on Beauty and the Beast with Hilton. Working with **churches** is key to the success of this project. Chris is available to assist churches with their ministry to children in their local community. This could be anything from assisting a school chaplain with a school assembly to helping with a Holiday Club. Chris is keen to explore with churches, on an individual basis, how he might best be used in their context. Options may include:

**Holiday Club** – Chris would organise and lead a children's Holiday Club in your church. Chris would head up a team of volunteers from your church to run the club for the children of your local community.

**Children's Work Training** - Training sessions on various aspects of Children's Work, from leading a small group to using puppets in ministry.

**Children's Clubs** – Chris can help with getting a Children's Club started or come along and lead one of your Children's Club sessions.

**Children's Address** - A new face on a Sunday morning leading the children's address
